The DACUN Multimedia Index (DMMI) is published by the Davao Colleges and Universities Network. It includes multimedia materials both print and non-print in various formats (electronic resources, videorecordings, soundrecordings, maps and transparencies etc.) acquired by DACUN libraries for their respective institutions. There is no limitation as to the scope of the subject for this volume as it is desired to cover all topics of multimedia resources with the exception that indexed collections are curriculum-based.

**The Entries**

Each entry contains the following essential information:

- a- Subject
- b- Author, Writer, Producer, Director etc.
- c- Title of the multimedia resource
- d- Edition
- e- Date and year of publication
- f- Physical description
- g- Call Number
- h- DACUN Resource Locator labeled as DRL in the text
